About Pack 703: Pack 703 was formed in the summer of 2003. The Pack is currently chartered at Mansfield Bible Church and draws many (but not all) of its Cub Scouts from Roberta Tipps Elementary and Nancy Neal Elementary.

Joining Pack 703: Your boy can immediately start participating in Cub Scout activities, which are designed to achieve the goals of Scouting: citizenship training, character development, and personal fitness. In addition, they can earn patches, belt loops and pins for learning new academics, sports and skills. These skills will help your boy develop a love and respect for the great outdoors. Our Adult Leaders are trained to help guide and protect your son during all Pack activities.

Costs: Registration fee is \$45 per boy & \$10 per Adult (includes \$12 subscription to BSA's *Boys Life Magazine*).

The Program: Monthly Pack Meetings at Mansfield Bible Church, 2351 Country Club Dr. in Mansfield on the third Thursdays at 7pm. Den Meetings are usually held twice a month on Monday evenings at 6:30pm. The goal of our Den Meetings are to help the Cub Scouts build friendships with one another, and work on their progress towards various ranks. Our goal is always to have fun. Your boy will need to wear his Class A uniforms to the Pack Meeting and their Class B uniforms to the Den Meetings. (Details provided separately).

Pack 703 school year activities:

- September** **Pack 703 Fellowship** – Designed to meet/reconnect with fellow scouts and their families and start working towards advancements.
- October** **Pack 703 Fall Family Campout** – One night campout for the entire family at Loyd Park. There are some scheduled activities within each Den. Dinner Saturday night & breakfast Sunday morning provided.
- November** **Turkey Shoot** – Learn to safely fire BB guns at local Park (Council event)
Rocket Shoot – Boys will learn to build and launch model rockets (Pack event)
- December** **Pack Christmas Party** – Lock-in at the Church on a Friday night, games, food and fun!
- January** **Pinewood Derby** – Design, build, decorate and race your own pinewood racer.
Cub-O – This is a competition where the boys learn to capture flags while using a map and compass.
- February** **Blue & Gold Banquet** – A theme celebration of our Pack and all of the achievements our boys have made thus far in the school year. It includes a dinner, cake decorating contest and an awards ceremony.
- March** **Rocket Academy** – at Sid Richardson Ranch (optional Pack function)
- April** **Pack 703 Spring Family Campout/Raingutter Regatta** - Campout for the entire family at Loyd Park.
- May** **Crossover Ceremony** – Where the boys “crossover” to their new ranks. Final awards are given and the Pack recharter everyone for the next Scouting Year.

Summer Activities:

- June** **Tejas District Cub Scout Day Camp** – A week of outdoor fun and programs not regularly found in Den or Pack activities. The boys will earn MANY achievements during this week.
- July** **Arlington 4th of July Parade** – Pack 703 has a float in the Arlington parade, decorated by the scouts
- August** **Baseball Scout Nights**
